# Why we Monitor

Tampa Bay and the people, economy, and ecosystems that inhabit it, rely on good water quality. Sewage exposes recreators to bacteria, viruses, and parasites, which can cause skin infections and rashes, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, earache, respiratory problems, hepatitis, and more. In addition to the human health risk, sewage pollution can lead to increases in the intensity and frequency of harmful algal blooms such as red tide. Tampa Bay Waterkeeper and regulatory agencies test waters for enterococci, a fecal indicator bacteria. Our sampling compliments that of regulatory agencies by filling in the gaps; we test sites that are common recreation spots not tested by other agencies. The bacteria we test for is present in the gut and feces of warm-blooded animals, including humans. Therefore, it is used as an indicator organism because it closely links water quality with contamination by human feces. Tampa Bay Waterkeeper analyzes sampling results and works to find and eliminate sources of pollution.
